A **noun** is the name of a person, animal, place or thing.

Types of nouns:

Proper Noun is a **special name** that names a particular person, place, animal or thing and it always begins with a **capital letter**. E.g. Rahul, Mumbai, Bruno and Taj Mahal.

Common Noun is a **general name** shared by people, places, animals or things. E.g. man, school, dog and car.

Collective Noun is a word used to denote a **collection**. E.g. team, family, army, class, bunch etc.

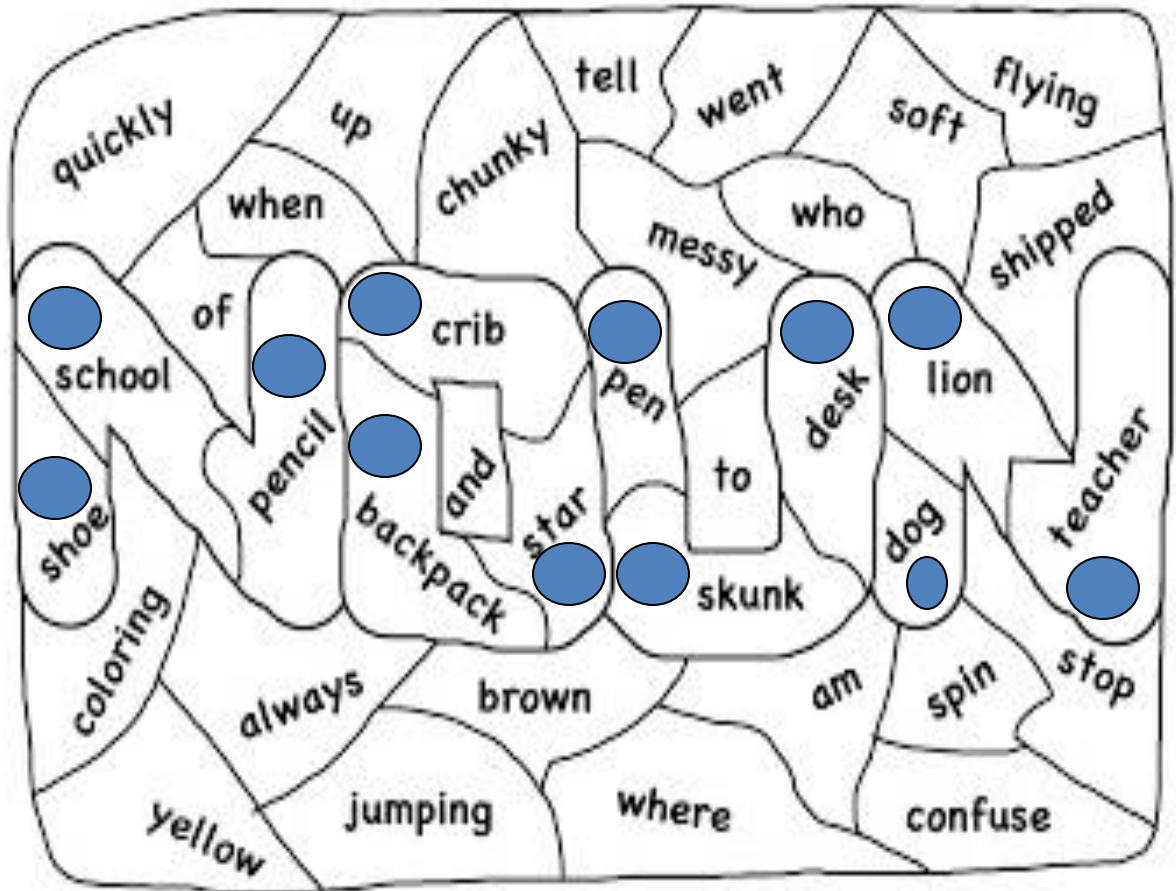
