Now, in the above sentence Ram has been replaced by 'he'.

In the same way all the naming words can be replaced by he, she or it.





1. Reema is a girl. Reema likes reading.



2. Reema is a girl. She likes reading.

**She refers to Reema and we use she in place of someone's name.
So, she is used for female gender like a girl, woman, queen, sister, aunt etc.**





1. Ajay loves football. Ajay plays football everyday.



2. Ajay loves football. He plays football everyday.

So, he refers to Ajay and we use he in place of someone's name. He is used for male gender for example name of any man or boy. We can use he in place of any noun word which refers to a male for example a boy or man like king, actor, father, uncle etc.





1. A tiger is a wild animal. A tiger eats meat only.



2. A tiger is a wild animal. It eats meat only.



1. Ritu has a laptop. The laptop is very useful.



2. Ritu has a laptop. It is very useful.

Here, it refers to both tiger and laptop. So it is used when talking about animals or non living things.
