Sub: Phased reopening of school post Covid-19 pandemic

Dear Parent,

1st October 2021


As per the mandate given by the PMC, the schools in this region to reopen for in-person teaching-learning from classes VIII to XII with effect from 4th October 2021. Schools have been advised to take all necessary precautions for the safety of students, teachers and staff before the students are welcomed to start attending the off-line classes.

As part of precautions, the premises are being disinfected regularly. Sanitizers and dispensers have been put in place at strategic points for easy access by all. The phased reopening scheme and other related details are as below.

- 1) Classes IX and X will reopen w.e.f. 4th October 2021 (Monday).
- 2) Classes XI and XII will reopen w.e.f. 11th October 2021 (Monday).
- 3) Phased reopening of other classes will follow and will be notified separately.
- 4) To maintain physical distancing in the classrooms, hybrid class teaching will be carried out.
- 5) Reporting time will be from 8:00 am to 8:10 am.
- 6) Classes will be from 8:30 am to 12 noon. Dispersal will start at 12:05 pm.
- 7) **Classes IX and XI will use Gate 1 only for entry and exit (Niramaya Hospital side)**
- 8) **Classes X and XII will use Gate 2 only for entry and exit(Rail Vihar Side)**
- 9) **The above schedule would undergo change if there is any direction from the authorities and as per emerging needs.**
- 10) No school transportation will be provided until further notice. Parents will be required to drop students at the start and take back students at the dispersal.
- 11) 10 min reporting time is provided so that there is no crowding at the gates. Parents and students are required to understand this and cooperate. **Do not wait up to 8:30 AM.**
- 12) There will be compulsory temperature testing of students at the school gates. *Any student with "above normal temperature" will not be allowed to attend the school.*
- 13) Parents to ensure that your ward is symptom free whenever he/she comes to school.
- 14) **Parents have to inform the school if the child was ever infected or exposed to the Covid-19. If yes, then negative report has to be produced.**
- 15) **In case a student shows any symptom or feels sick, the parent must be in a position to immediately take him/her home from school.**
- 16) A consent form is attached to this communication. All parents have to compulsorily download the same, fill it with details and signature, and send it with the student on the day he /she joins school. **Students without consent form will not be allowed to join.**
- 17) **It is compulsory that students wear facial mask at all times in the school. Also, students must maintain physical distancing inside and outside the school premises.**

- 18) Mask wearing should be meaningful and not for namesake. The mask shall cover from above the nose and to the bottom of chin. Improper mask wearing hurts self and others.
- 19) **Any willful violator in regard to (18) above will be asked to leave the school or the parent would be called to take away the child.** There will be no compromise in this matter.
- 20) Students are advised to bring their own sanitizers though enough devices and liquid are made available in the school.
- 21) The school has drinking water facility, but to avoid gathering near the water taps, the students must carry their own water bottles

An important advice: Parents have to sit down with their children, seriously talk to them and to mentally prepare them to follow the safety norms prescribed by the school authorities.
