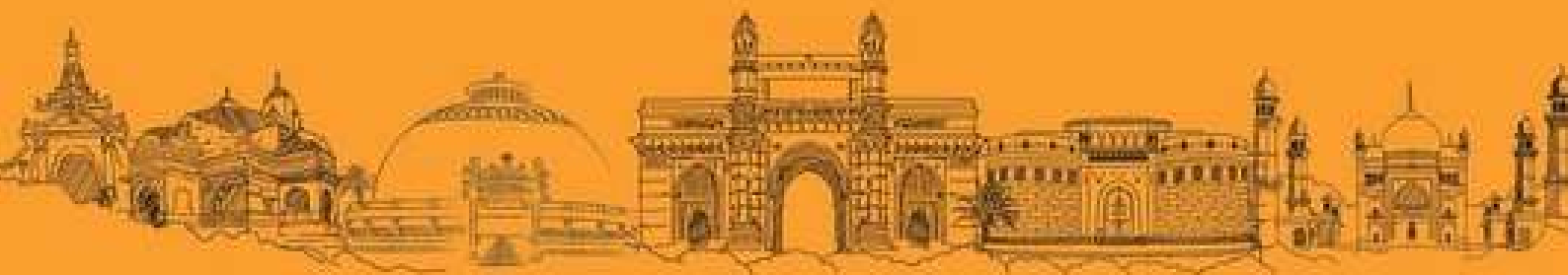

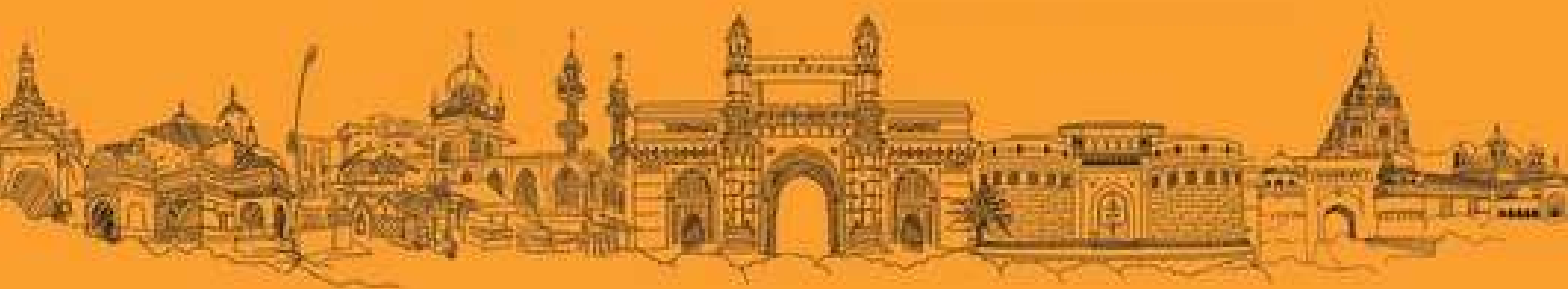

Festivals : Maharashtra

- **Gudi Padhwa** : Gudi Padhwa the harvest festival of Maharashtra. Gudi is a symbol of victory, characterized by a bamboo stick with a silk cloth. It is garlanded with flowers and has sweets offered to it.
- **Ganesh Chaturthi** : Most Famous Festival of Maharashtra. In August, preparations for the auspicious day when Lord Ganesh was born begin with great enthusiasm. It is an 11-day festival, beginning with the installation of beautifully sculpted Ganesh idols in homes and large pandals, colorfully decorated, depicting religious and cultural themes.
- **Nag Panchami** : Nag Panchami is celebrated in the honour of the Snake God Shesha Nag on the fifth day of the holy month of Shravan.



Tourism : Maharashtra

Maharashtra attracts tourists from other Indian states and foreign countries. Some tourist places are:

- **Mumbai** - the heart of Maharashtra, the financial capital and entertainment capital of the country. Places of interest here include Gateway of India, The Bandra-Worli Sea Link, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Vastu Sangrahalaya, Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus, a humongous architectural stone structure built by the British more than 200 years ago.
- **Pune** – It is known as the Oxford of the East with the presence of a wide range of educational institutions.
- **Nasik** - The city is called the "Wine Capital of India" as more than half of India's vineyards and wineries are located here.

Festivals : Odisha

- **Durga Puja:** Durga Pooja is the most important festival of Orissa which is magnificently celebrated all over the state of Orrisa. The streets are lighted up and Pandals are decorated to set the spirit of festivity among the people. The huge idols of Durga Maa along with two other avatars of Maa Laxmi and Maa Saraswati are immaculate in the Pandals.
- **Kalinga Mahotsav :** It is celebrated to mark the victory of peace over war. To pay tribute to the martyrs of Mauryan dynasty, various Martial art acts are performed on the outskirts of Bhubaneswar at Dhauli Shanti Stupa. It is at this place that Ashoka decided to live a peaceful and non- violent life.
- **Konark sun festival :** Dedicated purely to the beauty of Konark Sun Temple and the elegance of Odissi dance, this festival is beyond religions and customs. The festival is celebrated to pay tribute to the ancient beauty of the Konark Temple.

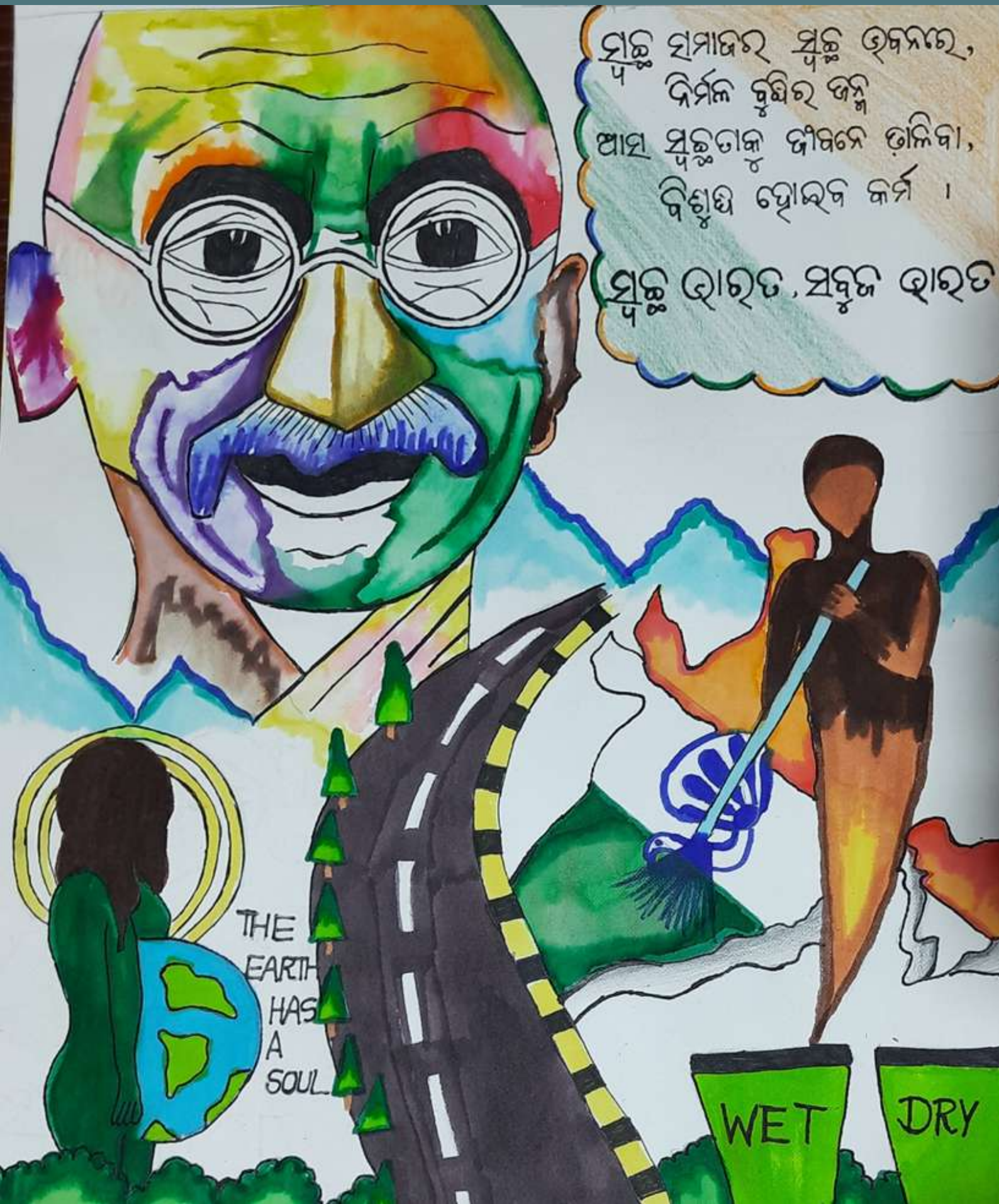

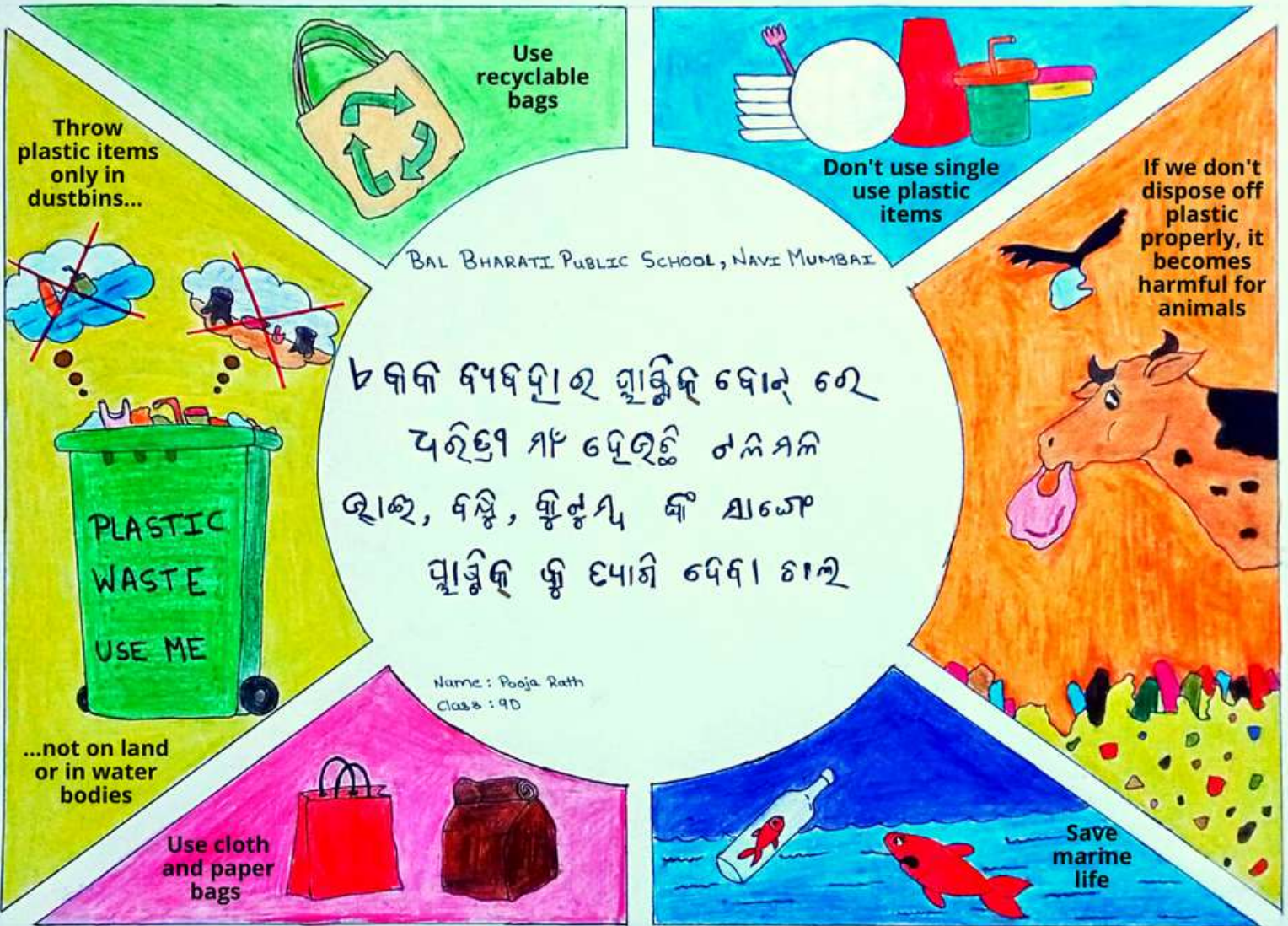
