# 1. Scholastic

#### A. Assessment: Term 1 & 2

- i) Periodic Test 1 and Periodic Test 2 (40 marks is converted in to 10 marks)
- ii) Internal Assessment for Term-1 and Term-2
- a. Portfolio/Notebook Submission 5 Marks
  - Subject wise notebook performance and record will be maintained by the subject teacher.
  - Regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep will be assessed.
- b. Subject Enrichment Activities/ Multiple Assessment 5 Marks
  - Respective subject teachers of each scholastic subject will conduct these activities and maintain records. There will be at least **one activity per subject per term.**

#### iii) Term 1 and Term 2/Annual Assessment - 80 marks

- Written Exam for 80 Marks in each scholastic subject.
- Exam dates will be announced by the school.

## 2. Co-Scholastic

Meant to encourage the holistic development of the student. The students' performance would be graded on a **3- point grading scale(A to C)**. There will be no descriptive indicators & no upscaling of grades.

- i) Work Education (skill based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community )
- ii) Art Education (Visual & Performing Arts)
- iii) Health and Physical Education.

## 3. Discipline

Intended to enable students to become desirable human beings. Students' performance in discipline would be assessed by the respective class teachers with reference to Attendance, Sincerity, Behavior, and Values on a **3- point grading scale (A to C)**. There will be no descriptive indicators & no upscaling of grades.

#### Note:

- A student must put in a minimum of 75 % attendance during the academic year and clear all the dues to appear in the Annual Examination.
- In case a student is likely to be absent for any test or examination the parents should seek prior permission in writing. In case of illness, a doctor's certificate must be submitted along with a leave letter.
- A student who has not appeared for any test / examination will not be considered for any award / prize on overall performance.
- No retest will be conducted if a student does not appear for any of the pen paper assessments (in part or whole).
- If the student does not appear for any pen paper assessment due to reasons of representing the school in any outside activity/ programme,etc.with prior permission of the authority then an average of the rest of the assessments will be granted as the score.
- In case of late admission, the parent needs to provide Attendance and Result Documents from the previous school.

## **Promotion Policy**

A student will be eligible for promotion only if he/ she secures minimum 33% marks in all scholastic subjects individually and in aggregate at least grade C in all non-scholastic subjects.
