## **Assessment Policy (Session 2022-23)**

### **Classes: 9-10**

#### **1) Scholastic :**

##### **Class 9**

- The Annual Exam (accounting for 80 marks overall) would be conducted by the school.
- Average of the 2 best scores from Periodic test 1, Periodic test 2 and Periodic Test3, will be taken for calculation and will be converted into 5 marks.
- Internal assessment is inclusive of Periodic tests, Portfolio, Multiple assessment and Subject enrichment activities comprising 5 marks each.
- Class 9 students will have to secure 33% marks each in Internal assessment and in the Annual assessment for promotion to Class 10.

- For class 10, the Yearly Exam (accounting for 80 marks overall) would be conducted by the CBSE.
- Average of the 2 best scores from Periodic test 1, Periodic test 2 and Periodic Test3, will be taken for calculation and will be converted into 5 marks.
- Internal assessment is inclusive of Periodic tests, Portfolio, Multiple assessment and Subject enrichment activities comprising 5 marks each.

- Class 10 students will have to secure 33% marks in the internal assessment and also 33% marks in the written Annual board assessment to pass class 10.

## **2. Co-scholastic Activities**

Meant to encourage the holistic development of the student and their performance will be graded on a **5-point grading scale(A to E)**. There will be no descriptive indicators & no upscaling of grades.

- i. Health and Physical Education (Sports / Martial Arts / Yoga / Computers)
- ii. Art Education (Visual & Performing Arts)

## **3. Discipline**

Intended to enable students to become desirable human beings. The performance of the student for discipline will be assessed by the respective class teachers with reference to the Attendance, Sincerity, Behavior, and Values on a **3- point grading scale(A to C)**. There will be no descriptive indicators & no upscaling of grades.

### **Note:**

- A student must put in a minimum of 75 % attendance during the academic year and clear all the dues to appear in the Annual Examination.
- In case a student is likely to be absent for any internal test or examination the parents should seek prior permission in writing. In case of illness, a doctor's certificate must be submitted along with a leave letter.
- A student who has not appeared for any internal test / examination will not be considered for any award / prize on overall performance.
- **No retest** will be conducted for class 9, if a student does not appear for any of the pen paper assessments (in part or whole).
- If the student of Class 9 does not appear for the pen paper assessment due to reasons of representing the school in any outside activity/ programme,etc. with prior permission of the authority then an average of the rest of the assessments will be granted as the score.
- In case of late admission, the parent needs to provide Attendance and Result Documents from the previous school.

## **Promotion Policy**

### **Class 9:**

A student will be eligible for promotion only if he/ she secures minimum 33% marks in all scholastic subjects individually and in aggregate. In all Co-scholastic subjects students should secure minimum grade C. A student failing in any one or two of the five subjects will be granted a compartment. The student will have to pass in the compartment examination securing 33% marks.

### **Class 10:**

A student will be eligible for promotion only if he/ she secures minimum 33% marks in all scholastic subjects individually (Inclusive of internal and External marks) and in aggregate. In all Co-scholastic subjects students should secure minimum grade C . A student failing in any one of the five subjects will be granted a compartment and will have to pass in the compartment examination securing 33% marks.

**Class 10 promotion policy is as per the CBSE board and can be subject to change as per their directives.**
