To acquaint students and parents with the revised pattern of assessment by CBSE for the academic year 2022-23.


Assessment Scheme for 2022-23

There are two major areas of assessment:

- 1. Scholastic Assessment
 - Academic fields
 - Reflected in the form of marks and grades
- 2. Co-scholastic Assessment
 - Co-curricular activities
- Reflected in the form of grades

1. Scholastic Assessments

- ► There will be an Annual Examination (AISSE) conducted by CBSE based on the entire syllabus.
- ► The Annual Examination will be of 80 marks and 20 marks weightage shall be for Internal Assessment

Internal Assessment: 20 Marks

a) Periodic tests – 5 Marks

Three periodic tests will be conducted by the school. Average of the best two tests will be taken. This will have a weightage of 05 marks towards the final result.

b) Multiple Assessment-5 Marks

These may include – class tests, oral test, quiz, concept maps, projects, posters, presentations, enquiry based research work etc.

c) Subject Enrichment Activities - 5 Marks

These may include- Role play, JAM, Debate, chart preparation, project file, lab practical, model making etc.

d) Portfolio- 5 Marks

This would include classwork and other sample of student's work

Tentative Schedule of Periodic Tests (05 marks)

- By School (July)
- Time 1.5 hrs
- Syllabus 35% (approx.)

Periodic test-2/PT2 (80 marks)

- By School (September)
- Time 3 hrs

Periodic test-3/PT3 (40 marks)

- By School (November)
- Time 1.5 hrs
- Syllabus 80% (approx.)

2. Co-scholastic Assessments

- The Co-curricular activities will be assessed on a 5-point grading scale (A-E) and will have no descriptive indicators.
- ▶ No upscaling of grades.
- ▶ The students will be assessed in three areas:

a) Health and physical education (HPE)

Games and sports, health and fitness, SEWA, health and activity record

Work Experience (WE): Gardening/plantation, first-aid, cleanliness and sanitation drive, Dignity of labor, Eco club etc.

b) Art Education (AE)

Music, dance, drama, drawing and painting, modelling and sculpture, pottery and ceramic work, poetry, creative writing, craft etc.

c) Discipline

Regularity, punctuality, neatness, attitude, behavior towards classmates and teachers.
