
Social Skill/Value/Basic Courtesies & Manners - Care for plants, save water





Physical Development

- 1. To participate in indoor and outdoor activities.
- 2. To Demonstrate: healthy eating habits hygiene and sanitation practices
- **3. To Understand:** differences in various textures, smells and sounds.
- **4. Gross motor coordination:** activities like walking, running, jumping, climbing, dancing etc.
- **5. Fine motor skills:** activities like scribbling, coloring, clay moulding, tearing and pasting etc.





Socio-Emotional and Ethical Development

- 1. Learns to wait for their turn while playing, during activities and to follow simple rules
- 2. To Care and Share: caring behavior with hugs, pats etc. and sharing of belongings with others
- **3. To be responsible:** to keep materials and toys back in their appropriate place after use
- **4. Learns about natural surroundings:** through the activities like sowing, watering and caring for the plants
- **5. To Understand** the importance of air, sunlight and water for the plants
- **6. Circle Time activities:** Save water, closing the faucet when not in use while brushing teeth, how to wash your hands.





Cognitive Development

- 1. Observing plants growing from a sapling.
- **2. Comparison and Classification:** objects based on colour, size or shape
- **3. Play Time:** stringing beads with big holes, puzzles with knobs, wooden blocks, etc.
- 4. To observe and explore the environment (through Five senses)
- 5. **Pre-number vocabulary:** big-small, up-down, tall-short, thick -thin, near-far
- **6. Recognition of shape :** circle, square, triangle and tracing it in sand tray
- 7. Count and give up to ten objects when asked to
- **8. Memory Game :**2–3 objects seen at a time
- 9. Comparison of two objects.
- **10.Recognition**: Numbers from 1-5







Language and Literacy Development


- **1. Introduction** of letters L l, T t with story and song
- **2. Recognition** of letter 'L' 'l' and 'T' 't' with related pictures of words like lion, lorry, leg, lips, lamp, lime, turtle, tomato, truck, tap, tree, train etc.)
- 3. Developing **pincer grip with tracing** of letter 'L' 'l' and 'T' 't' in sand tray



- ChuChu and the Plant






Aesthetic and Cultural Development
